Change-of-Coverage Periods



Sept. 4 - 24, 2024

Winter Term (new students only): Jan. 6 - 24, 2025

Spring Term (only new students and co-op students who weren't on academic term in fall 2024 or winter 2025): May 5 - 26, 2025

During the applicable period above, you can opt out of these services (you must have proof of other coverage to opt out of the health portion of the Plan), change your Plan coverage, or enrol your family in the Plan.
